Re: Consideration of awarding a contract to Sparks Concrete & Asphalt to

resurface Sea Isle Circle, Coral Circle and Reef Road (Bid No. 25-B-001) in the amount of \$125,232 as funded by a Volusia County 2024/2025 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) to include the remaining streets on our street resurfacing list which includes Cambridge Circle, Bristol Lane, Windle Lane, Hamlin Drive East, Ponderosa Drive East, and Lambright Road at an

additional cost of \$350,056 as budgeted in the current year.

Date: March 6, 2025

In September 2024, the City Council approved a Subrecipient Grant Agreement with Volusia County for the 2024/2025 CDBG (Community Development Block Grant) in the amount of \$93,016 for the Street Repaying Project for Sea Isle Circle, Coral Circle and Reef Road.

To comply with the City's purchasing policy as well as CDBG requirements, staff utilized a bid process seeking contractors for the resurfacing project. Proposals were received until Wednesday, March 5, 2025, at which time the submitted bids were publicly opened in the City Council Chamber Room located inside City Hall.

Based on the bids received, staff recommends awarding a contract to Sparks Concrete and Asphalt to complete the resurfacing of Sea Isle Circle, Coral Circle and Reef Road (Bid No. 25-B-001) in the amount of \$125,232 as funded by a Volusia County 2024/2025 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG).

As the streets of Cambridge Circle, Bristol Lane, Windle Lane, Hamlin Drive east, Ponderosa Drive east and Lambright Road are also slated for the current fiscal year, the selected contractor has agreed to same pricing for these roads as proposed. As a result, staff requests the City Council also extend the contract with Sparks Concrete and Asphalt to include the resurfacing of these additional streets at an additional cost of \$350,056. The total cost of the award, if approved, would be \$475,288 which is within the budgeted amount in the current year. The contractor is set to begin in April and be completed will all of the designated roadways by May 2025.

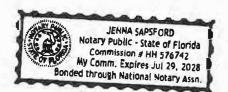
